Faculty Senators' Collective Ranking of Faculty Lines <br> Currently Open Positions: <br> - Nursing -- Susan Bonnell and Katherine Spence retired <br> - Business -- Replacement line <br> - Psychology - One replacement line for Jonathan Dunning <br> - Criminal Justice -- new line, not replacement <br> Lecturers vs. Assistant Professor line: <br> - 12 month Bio/A\&P lecturer lines - Bio 189 \& A\&P (two currently being searched for; requested additional lines to serve pre-nursing) <br> - Nursing lecturers -- can be hard to find Phd psych clinical faculty; need more for med search <br> Nursing positions: <br> - requesting six new positions <br> - 48 minimum class size <br> - Want to be able to open additional sections to reduce course size <br> - Need to maintain certain ratio of FT:PT to keep accreditation; requiring 12 month positions <br> - Build up TT positions to be ready for Masters in Nursing Education <br> Education positions: <br> - Speech Pathology positions -- really need to run program in Fall <br> - ECE position -- ideally get one to have faculty help develop program <br> LAS positions: <br> - Two new lecturer positions for Biology to cover Bio 189 and A\&P; hope to recruit from two already open lines <br> - TT Bio faculty -- to hire someone with expertise in plants (no existing expertise); 4 FT in bio <br> - TT Atmospheric Science -- build out ERS; Senator Lagarde is the only faculty in ERS, can cover other possible areas; health sci, data science <br> - TT Human Health Sciences -- no one to oversee alternative pathway for pre-nursing, could possibly teach Chem 108, Bio 189, and Pharmacology <br> - TT Data Science -- Provost-initiated position; data science degree has not been developed; unclear what courses would teach while setting up degree, but could possibly teach stats, chem, bio, psy depending on area of expertise <br> - Psych positions -- no expertise in Bio/physio or Clinical; have high SCH | Information, For Possible Action |
