

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) 6.1

Selection and Awarding of Students

POLICY STATEMENT

Nevada State College will award Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) to students according to the following priority groups until funds are exhausted:

- 1. Federal Pell Grant recipients with a zero EFC;
- 2. Federal Pell Grant recipients in ascending order from lowest to highest EFC;
- 3. Zero EFC students not receiving Federal Pell Grant;
- 4. Any remaining students with need in ascending order from lowest to highest EFC.

Award amounts will be \$300 per term for full time enrollment (12 or more credits), prorated to \$225 for three quarter time enrollment (9-11 credits), \$150 for half-time enrollment (6-8 credits), and \$75 for less than half-time enrollment (1-5 credits).
