B. CSS Profile Application

The CSS Profile, an application *similar* to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), is managed and maintained by <u>College Board</u>. Your data will be forwarded to Nevada State University and will be viewed by NS Student Financial Services staff.

What you will need to do:

- 1. The application is lengthy, we suggest allowing at least an hour to complete the application.
- 2. Gather your income tax information for 2023.
- 3. If you do not meet one of the <u>federal criteria for independent status</u>, your parents will also need to provide their 2023 income tax information.
- 4. Go to https://cssprofile.collegeboard.org/
- 5. Sign into your College Board account to complete the 2025-26 CSS Application.
 - a. New users will be prompted to create a College Board account.
- 6. Make sure to include Nevada State University (4572) in the list of schools you want your information sent to.
- 7. If you are at the end of the application and you are asked to make a payment, STOP and save your application!
 - a. Contact <u>finaid@nevadastate.edu</u> to request a fee waiver for the CSS Application so you can complete the application at no cost to you.
- 8. If additional documentation is required your MY NevadaState Student Center To-Do List will be updated, so be sure to check your Student Center often.
