



Maintaining Eligibility for the Scorpion Academic Scholarship

Enrollment Requirement

To receive your scholarship each semester, you must be enrolled full-time (12 or more financial aid-eligible credits).

NSU checks enrollment after the add/drop period ends each semester. If your enrollment drops below full-time, your scholarship may be reversed.

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

You must maintain good SAP standing to keep your scholarship:

- Minimum NSU GPA: 2.0 cumulative
- Credit Completion Rate: 67% of attempted credits

If you're placed on SAP suspension, your scholarship will be suspended until you meet SAP standards again or are granted a SAP Probation.

Regaining Eligibility

If you lose eligibility, you may regain your scholarship in a future fall or spring semester (before it expires) by:

- Returning to full-time enrollment
- Meeting SAP requirements

Final Semester Exception

If you're graduating and don't need 12 credits, your scholarship may be prorated:

- 75% for $\frac{3}{4}$ time
- 50% for $\frac{1}{2}$ time
- 25% for less-than- $\frac{1}{2}$ time

Submit the Scholarship Exception Form after applying for graduation.
